

2023 Parade Information

(Application deadline: June 16, 2023)



When: Tuesday, July 4, 2023 starting at 6:00 p.m. Please plan to arrive by 5:00 p.m.

Where: The parade route will begin at the intersection of Meadowbridge Drive and Dayton-Xenia Road. Entries will be lined up north and south of Dayton Xenia, along Meadowbridge.

General Information

- The parade route is 1.2 miles. The parade will move at the rate of 120 adult steps per minute. Any unit incapable of maintaining that pace for the duration of the parade should not apply to participate.
- All units with children are expected to station adults along the parade route to assist tired marchers. Alternative uniforms or costumes should be available in case of excessive heat, cold, or rainy weather.
- **DO NOT endanger spectators by throwing candies, gum, etc. from your parade unit. We shall withdraw any unit from the parade if items are thrown.**
- If you have live animals, please plan on picking up after them. You must provide your own clean-up crew.
- Participants are required to provide their own vehicles.
- No firecrackers or discharge of firearms are allowed. Violators will be removed from the parade.
- Individuals and organizations in the parade are expected to perform courteously, in good taste, and with safety in mind at all times during the formation, execution, and dismissal of the parade. Marshals will remove any person or unit that violates this regulation.
- All individuals and organizations participating in the parade are subject, while in the City of Beaver Creek, to the laws and regulations of that jurisdiction. Failure to adhere to those laws and regulations, or to obey the lawful command of an official empowered to give such a command, will be cause for immediate removal from the parade and may cause for arrest and/or fine.
- No alcoholic beverages are permitted on or around any parade units.

For the consideration stated above, I further agree that in the event that my child repudiates or attempts to repudiate such release, I will personally indemnify and safe harmless the City of Beaver Creek Parks, Recreation and Culture Department, its successors and assigns, for any and all loss and damage occasioned thereby.
