Pickleball—Indoor

COVID-19 Responsible Restart Guidelines

The City of Beavercreek Parks, Recreation and Culture staff and our volunteers are dedicated to making your safety, health and wellness our top priority. We are committed to providing our community with a safe, welcoming environment for in-person classes.

Key Changes

- Class sizes will be limited based upon available space and ability to social distance.
- Social distancing of a minimum of 6 ft. will be maintained the duration of class.
- Public restrooms will be limited to the number of users at any one time.
- Water fountains are disabled.
 Participants should bring their own water bottles.
- Do not arrive more than 10 minutes prior to class.
- Should not congregate in common areas or parking lot before or after class.
- No food will be permitted.

Staff/Volunteers

- Must self-evaluate themselves for COVID-19 symptoms before each class.
- Face coverings are required. Check in, walking around the room, going to the restroom, etc. all require a mask.
- When actively teaching during class, a mask will not be required when able to maintain a social distancing of a minimum of 6 ft. from participants.
- Will thoroughly sanitize hands before and after class at sanitization station.
- Ensure social distancing and sanitization guidelines are maintained throughout the duration of class.
- Will set up the game, set up seating for the "bench" area, sanitize and set out pickleballs and paddles for participant use.
- Will sanitize the equipment and chairs, high touch areas and remove the net afterward.
- Will check-in members including: Screening questions, temperature check, and observe signs and symptoms.



Participants

- Must self-evaluate themselves for COVID-19 symptoms before each class and not attend class if they are exhibiting symptoms or have been exposed to COVID-19.
- Must have temperature taken upon arrival at class. If you have a fever (100 degrees or higher), you will not be permitted to attend class.
- Shall be asked pre-screening COVID-19 questions.
- Must use the sanitization station to thoroughly sanitize hands to check-in, after finishing a game, and before and after class.
- Face coverings are required. Check in, walking around the room, going to the
 restroom, etc. all require a mask. Those that are actively participating during class will
 not be required to wear a facial covering.
- Equipment and items related to this activity must be sanitized before, during and after every event.
- When not participating in a game, you must sit in the designated "bench" area and wear a mask.
- Avoid using your hand to pick up balls; use your racquet/foot to pick up balls.
- No touch rule is in effect. All individuals must avoid physical contact with others
 including high fives, huddles, or other close contact occurring before, during, and after
 the events. The is no spitting permitted at any time before, during, and after all events.
- You <u>must</u> call to register one week in advance. If you do not pre-register, you will not
 be permitted to participate. If you are placed on a waiting list, we will notify you if
 someone cancels and let you know if you can attend.
