COVID-19 Responsible Restart Guidelines

The City of Beavercreek Parks, Recreation and Culture and The Piano Preparatory School instructor team is dedicated to making your safety, health and wellness our top priority. We are committed to providing our community with a safe, welcoming workout environment upon returning to in-person classes.

Key Changes

- Class sizes will be limited based upon available space and ability to social distance.
- Social distancing of a minimum of 6 ft. will be maintained the duration of class.
- Public restrooms will be limited to one user at any given time.
- Participants are strongly encouraged to bring their own water bottles.
- Shared equipment will be sanitized between every individual user in class.

Instructors

- Must self-evaluate themselves and their children for COVID-19 symptoms before each class.
- Will wear a mask during check-in procedures, and any time within 6 ft. distance of participants.
- Will thoroughly sanitize hands before and after class.
- Will wipe high-contact surfaces such as doorknobs, light switches, etc. before and after class.
- Ensure social distancing and sanitization guidelines are maintained throughout the duration of class.

Participants

- Must self-evaluate themselves and their children for COVID-19 symptoms before each class and not attend class if they are exhibiting symptoms or have been exposed to COVID-19.
- Must thoroughly sanitize hands before and after class.
- Face coverings are required when entering the building.
- Parents/guardians, family members, guest, etc. that have not registered for class will not be allowed in the facility.
- Should not congregate in common areas or parking lot before or after class.
- Upon arrival students will wait in their car until motioned to the entrance by the instructor.
- At the conclusion of lesson/camp, instructors will open the exterior doors and escort students to the sidewalk. Parents please remain in your car.
