Wartinger Park is a non-alcoholic facility per Code of Ordinance 95.18. Alcohol is only permitted upon approval from the Parks Director. A liquor liability policy is required with a minimum of \$1,000,000 listing the CITY as an additional insured.

Code of Ordinance 95.18 (O)

No person shall consume, possess or display the presence of any alcoholic beverage in a park, except within a reserved building or area. For the purpose of this section, the term "alcoholic beverages" shall mean beer and/or intoxicating liquor as defined in R.C. § 4301.01. The term "Reserved Building or Area" shall mean a building or area within a park the use which, pursuant to a permit issued by the Director, has been temporarily reserved by a person or persons to the exclusion of the general public.

All liquor liability insurance waivers will be purchased through the City of Beaver Creek to be covered through a Special Events Policy under Miami Valley Risk Management Association (MVRMA). An alcohol permit will not be signed until a liquor liability insurance policy is submitted. Liquor liability waiver must be purchased 30 days in advance of your rental. Liquor liability insurance waivers will be accepted by caterers, as long as the City is listed as an additional insured.
